Requirements:

To be considered for the Board of Directors of the Neillsville Area Chamber of Commerce, candidates should be owners, employees, **or** members of a NACC Member in good standing, demonstrating solid ethics and a strong commitment to community involvement and the Chamber's mission. Prospective board members must be available to attend monthly meetings, currently scheduled for the second Wednesday of each month at 7:00 am in the Chamber office. A high level of energy and enthusiasm is essential, along with the ability to dedicate time to the Chamber's activities and Board responsibilities. Additionally, candidates should be willing to serve on a Chamber Committee and volunteer for events, understanding that board members are not reimbursed for personal expenses. Building collegial relationships with fellow board members to foster consensus is crucial, and candidates must be able to commit to serving a full term. A full term is three years that runs from January 1st through December 31st.
